Applications are accepted until the due date from students in the Geosciences program during the spring semester. Awards are for the following fall/spring semesters. Scholarship awardees must continue in the Geosciences program during the fall/spring semesters to receive an award. Freshmen in the Geosciences program are first eligible to apply during their first spring semester at Baylor for awards the follow fall/spring. There are no scholarships available for incoming freshman. Our scholarships are awarded for one or two semesters at a time, and students must re-apply each year for scholarships in subsequent years. Scholarships are based on merit and/or need, and applying for a scholarship does not guarantee that funding is available.

This single form serves as an application for all scholarships for which a student is eligible. Scholarship award decisions are made by the Department of Geosciences Scholarships and Awards Committee.
